Guidelines for Contributors

- 1. Articles should not exceed 8,500 words for full-length articles and 3,000 words in the case of short notes and commentaries.
- 2. All submissions must be in Microsoft Word Format, correct British English, double line spacing in size 12, Times New Roman Font.
- 3. Authors are to submit an abstract of not more than 200 words, and a cover letter.
- 4. All reference should be placed in footnote.
- 5. Authors are required to use the Nigerian Association of Law Teachers' Uniform Format and Citation Guide (NALTUFCG) which is available online.
- 6. Submissions should be made to MIJLD.nials@gmail.com and ebubechi8@yahoo.com in electronic form only and must include a cover page with author's full name and affiliation, email address, phone number(s) and a word count of the article.
- 7. Submitted articles should be original and must not have been submitted or accepted elsewhere.
